SOCIAL MEDIA

I have been wanting to right this for some time and several further events in the past two weeks have confirmed that I need to share this with all parents.

Since September it has been reported to me that several parents have posted social media posts giving the full names of children who are not their own.

In most cases this is because the parent is frustrated at a child harming their own children. I understand that this is upsetting to see your child upset but this is illegal under Data Protection Law so we are asking that you do not post on social media the names of children within the school. If you are concerned about your child being harmed

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please come into school and speak to the class teacher, Mr Keaney the Learning Mentor or myself. We will then investigate your concerns and ensure that it is dealt with.

All the staff in school are vehemently against children being harmed so will support you in helping your child.
