SCHOOL UNIFORM AND PE KIT

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SCHOOL DINNERS

If your child has school dinners, please could you log onto the School Grid and order your child's dinners each week. If you do not have a login, please speak to the office and they will help you set one up.

SWIMMING AND PE

Swimming for Year 4 will start this Monday and all pupils must take part as it is an important part of the national curriculum. Mr Keaney, Mrs Crolla and Mrs Culpepper will be taking the pupils each week from 1.40-2.20pm.

All pupils will be told when their PE lessons are by the end of today. I will confirm the days for each class in next week's newsletter.

ATTENDANCE

The government have asked all schools to return to their usual attendance procedures and look to improve attendance over the next 12 months after the lockdowns. If your child is going to be absent from school, please either email me or ring the school to explain the absence and please notify us if you are going to be late in picking up your children by ringing the office on 0161 330 3169.

For families that drop below 90% or are persistently late (after 9am), Mr Keaney will be organising meetings to support you in improving your child's attendance. Unfortunately, schools have been asked to apply for fines through the local authority if attendance does not improve.

BUILDING WORKS

We have had extensive building works across the school during the summer and the building work will continue for the next few weeks. Each class has now been fitted with an outside door for the pupils to enter and leave school and ramps to these class doors in Key Stage 2 will be finished in the coming months. We are also having a new security fence installed around the field so that the pupils are more secure, and this will also hopefully stop people vandalising the equipment in the Early Years playground.

AUTUMN TERM CALENDAR

In next week's newsletter, I will share some of the events we have planned for this term. During the week beginning 13th September, all parents will be invited in to their child's class to find out about what their child will be learning and any key messages for the year. I will share the timetable for this next week but please try to attend, as this will be an important start in our push to further improve communication in school.





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COVID RESTRICTIONS

Although COVID restrictions have eased, we are still asking people to be respectful of keeping as much distance from other families as you can. If a child tests positive they will be expected to isolate and then Test and Trace will identify and notify any other close contacts. This should mean that schools will no longer need to isolate whole classes unless there is a surge within a class. Current guidance states that if a class has more than 10% of positive cases the pupils all may have to isolate to stop the spread of the virus.
