## Reading

Reading is incredibly important and your support in this learning process is vital.

# 10 Benefits of Reading

- 1. Children who read often and widely get better at it after all, practise makes perfect.
- 2. Reading exercises our brain Reading is a much more complex task for the human brain than for example, watching TV. Reading strengthens brain connections and builds new connections.
- 3. Reading improves concentration.
- 4. Reading teaches children about the world around them.
- 5. Reading improves vocabulary and language.
- 6. Reading develops a child's imagination.
- 7. Reading helps children to develop empathy as children develop they begin to consider how they would feel if placed in certain situations.
- 8. Reading is fun dreaming with your eyes open!
- 9. Reading is a great way to spend time together.
- 10. Reading promotes achievement in all subjects.

We issue every child with a banded reading book which they should read at home and bring back to school each day. Children also have access to the Key Stage libraries - they can select a book of their choice. Every child has a reading journal which should be signed to show they have read at home. We check this each morning and reward children regularly for reaching reading milestones.
